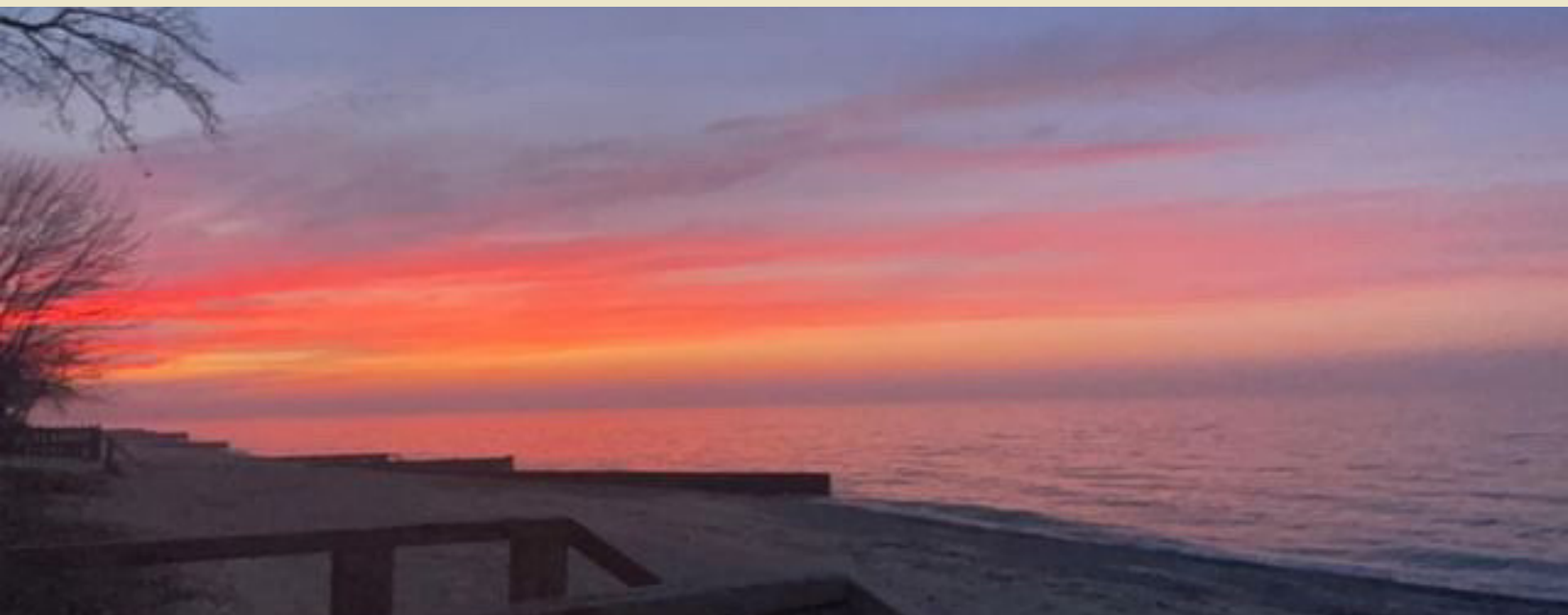

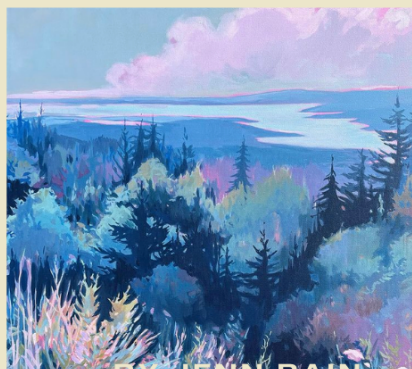

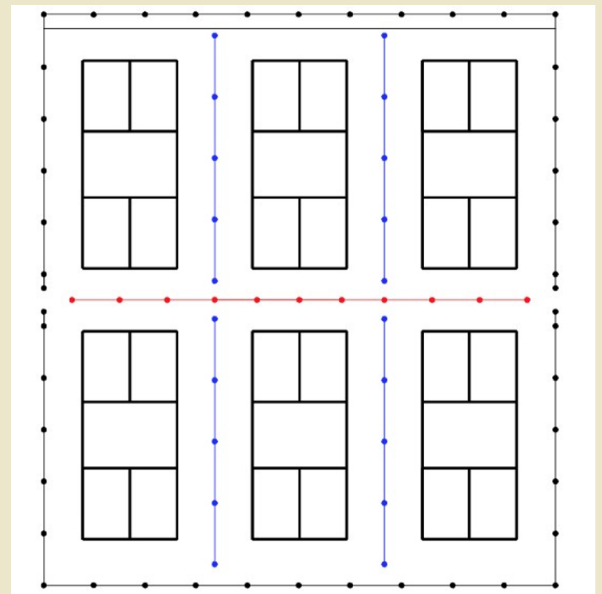
## PICKLEBALL NEWS

Since Pickleball was introduced at the Riding Club in 2021, it has increased in popularity several times over. To keep up, we increased from 2 to 4 courts in 2023 and look forward to upgrading to 6 dedicated courts on Courts #5 & #6 this Spring, as announced in the January Newsletter. Weather dependent, Courts 5 & 6 will be shut down to be resurfaced and converted at the End of May.

### Leagues + Game Play

To make up for the courts being out of service for the upgrades, we will start the Spring leagues as early as April 8 – so please watch out for Spring registration starting in March and keep fingers crossed that the weather will be fine for outdoor play.

Thanks to everyone who replied to the survey. We had a great response, proving that we will need even more leagues this year and also increase the choices of more fast-paced competitive leagues as well as “open” recreational leagues. For the leagues to be successful, we will need more Convenors.
